We work with local organisations to support children and young adults with disabilities who have experienced the extreme deprivation of institutional life or who live at home with families that face considerable challenges.

This year, in partnership with Friendship Church and the OT course at Ruse University, we are sending four qualified OT's to Ruse, each on a 6-month placement, which will enable us to achieve so much more and really 'make a difference'.

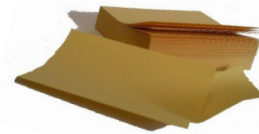
