It was great to be asked to work with some of the previous residents of Mogilino and their new support networks in Ruse, this October. James Hamilton and Mike Le-Surf delivered three days of training around self advocacy development and the ground work for supporting community inclusion.

The participants got very involved and

learned a lot about Circles of Support and other ways of supporting people to live ordinary lives. The highlight of the training was a PATH (Planning Alternative Tomorrows with Hope) that helped people to think about their goals and the future for Bulgarian's with learning disabilities.

We may be further down the road towards our goals in the UK. The 2001 government white paper "Valuing People" has given focus to the needs and wishes of people with learning disabilities. But we make as many mistakes in the UK as the rest

of the world and we learn as much as we offer regarding the lives of people with learning disabilities in Bulgaria.

Our current borough Equality and Diversity champion, Cllr Noelle, Hones is very interested in the lives of people with learning disabilities and we hope to change things in Brentwood as well as in Bulgaria. Watch this space!
